



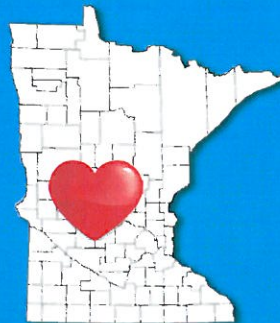

Getting to the Centracare Plaza:

From MN Hwy 15:

Traveling north on Highway 15: Proceed to County Road 120/20th St. N. Turn left, drive 0.3 mile. Turn left into CentraCare Health Plaza.

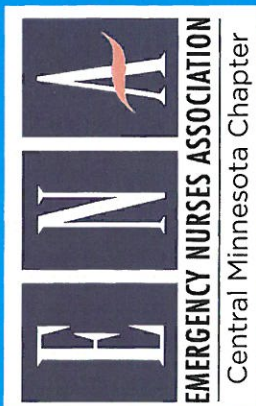
Traveling south on Highway 15: Proceed to County Road 120/20th St. No. (Second stop light after Mississippi River). Turn right, drive 0.3 mile. Turn left into CentraCare Health Plaza.

From Interstate I94

Traveling east or west on I-94: Exit I-94 at Highway 15. Proceed north on Highway 15 to County Road 120/20th St. N. Turn left, drive 0.3 mile. Turn left into CentraCare Health Plaza.

From US Hwy 10:

Traveling east on Highway 10: Take the Highway 15 exit to St. Cloud. Proceed to County Road 120/20th St. N. (Second stop light after Mississippi River). Turn right, drive 0.3 mile. Turn left into CentraCare Health Plaza.
Traveling west on Highway 10: Take the Highway 23 exit to St. Cloud. Continue through St. Cloud on Highway 23. Turn right on to Highway 15. Proceed north to County Road 120/20th St. N. Turn left, drive 0.3 mile. Turn left into the Centracare Health Plaza.
