From I-35W take the Highway 36 exit and turn south on Cleveland to Larpenteur. Go east (left) on Larpenteur to Gortner, turn south (right) on Gortner and go to Buford. Turn east (left) on Buford to the parking area.

From downtown St. Paul: Go west on I-94 to Snelling. Go north on Snelling to Larpenteur. Go west (left) on Larpenteur to Gortner, turn south (left) on Gortner and go to Buford. Turn east (left) on Buford to the parking area.

From downtown Minneapolis: Go east on I-94 to MN-280, exit number 236. (Note: exit to the left). Merge onto MN-280 north. Exit at Larpenteur. Take Larpenteur east (right) to Gortner (3rd traffic light). Turn south (right) on Gortner and go to Buford. Turn east (left) on Buford to the parking area.
