The 2011 Minnesota Toward Zero Deaths Conference provides a forum for sharing information on best practices in engineering, enforcement, education, and emergency medical and trauma services and for identifying new approaches to reduce the number of traffic fatalities and life-changing injuries on Minnesota roads.

This year, EMS personnel are eligible to apply for a scholarship to cover the \$95 conference registration fee (includes all conference materials, breakfasts, lunch, breaks, and a reception). Up to twenty scholarships will be granted on a first-come, first-serve basis for those who successfully complete the attached application form. Travel, lodging, and other expenses will not be covered and must be paid by the individual.
